

# 10<sup>th</sup> St Bikeway Project, Madison St to 9<sup>th</sup> Ave



## DESCRIPTION

The City of Oakland is developing a project to improve and extend the bike lanes on 10<sup>th</sup> St between Madison St and 9<sup>th</sup> Ave. The project is planned for construction in early 2017 as part of the completion of the 10<sup>th</sup> St Bridge Project at the Lake Merritt Channel. The bikeway project is funded by Measures B and BB, the countywide transportation sales taxes administered by the Alameda County Transportation Commission, using revenues dedicated solely to bicyclist and pedestrian projects.



The City of Oakland's Bicycle Master Plan calls for the installation of bikeways throughout Oakland to encourage bicycling as a healthy, non-polluting and affordable transportation option, helping Oakland to realize its sustainability and livability goals.

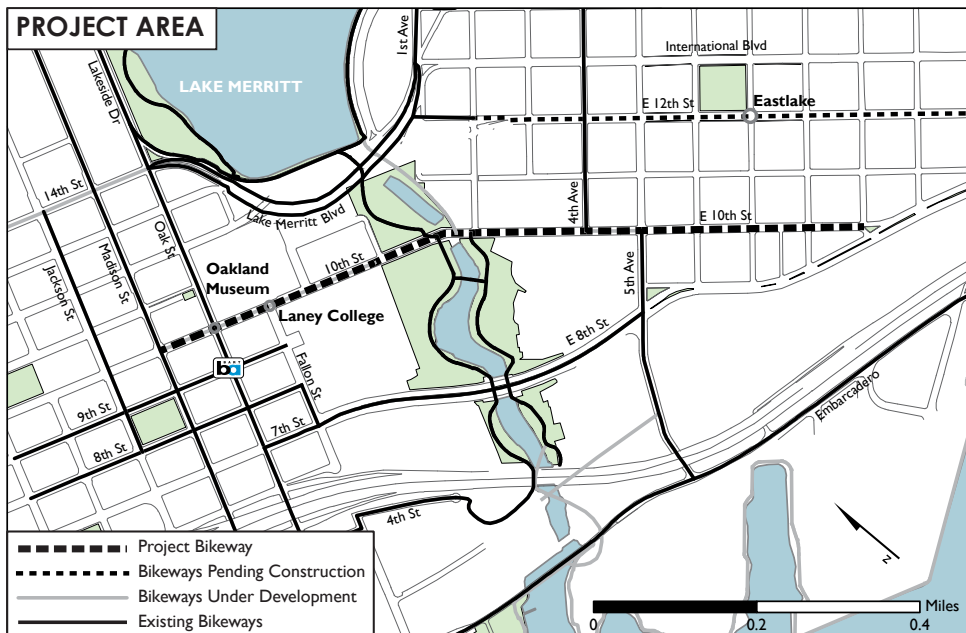
## GEOGRAPHIC CONTEXT

The 10<sup>th</sup> St Bikeway Project will complete a 0.9-mile link in the City's bikeway network connecting downtown Oakland to neighborhoods east of Lake Merritt. The project will connect to an existing bikeway on 4<sup>th</sup> Ave/5<sup>th</sup> Ave and a newly constructed bikeway on Madison St/Oak St across the length of downtown. The 10<sup>th</sup> St Bikeway Project is part of the draft alignment for the East Bay Greenway, a planned 16-mile regional trail that would extend from downtown Oakland to South Hayward generally along the alignment of the BART tracks.

## DESIGN

The 10<sup>th</sup> St Bikeway Project includes the following components. It will make minor improvements to the bike lanes that were installed in 2014 from Madison St to the Lake Merritt Channel and from 4<sup>th</sup> Ave to 5<sup>th</sup> Ave. It will close the gap in the bike lanes between 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave and 4<sup>th</sup> Ave that was created by the Oakland Unified School District's

construction project of the Downtown Educational Complex. It will extend the bike lanes from 5<sup>th</sup> Ave to 9<sup>th</sup> Ave (at E 8<sup>th</sup> St). A future project will connect the 10<sup>th</sup> St Bikeway to the E 12<sup>th</sup> St Bikeway via E 8<sup>th</sup> St (9<sup>th</sup> Ave to 14<sup>th</sup> Ave). The 10<sup>th</sup> St Bikeway Project includes spot repairs to the pavement throughout the project area.
