

Broadway Terrace Bikeway Project (Broadway to Clarewood Dr)



DESCRIPTION

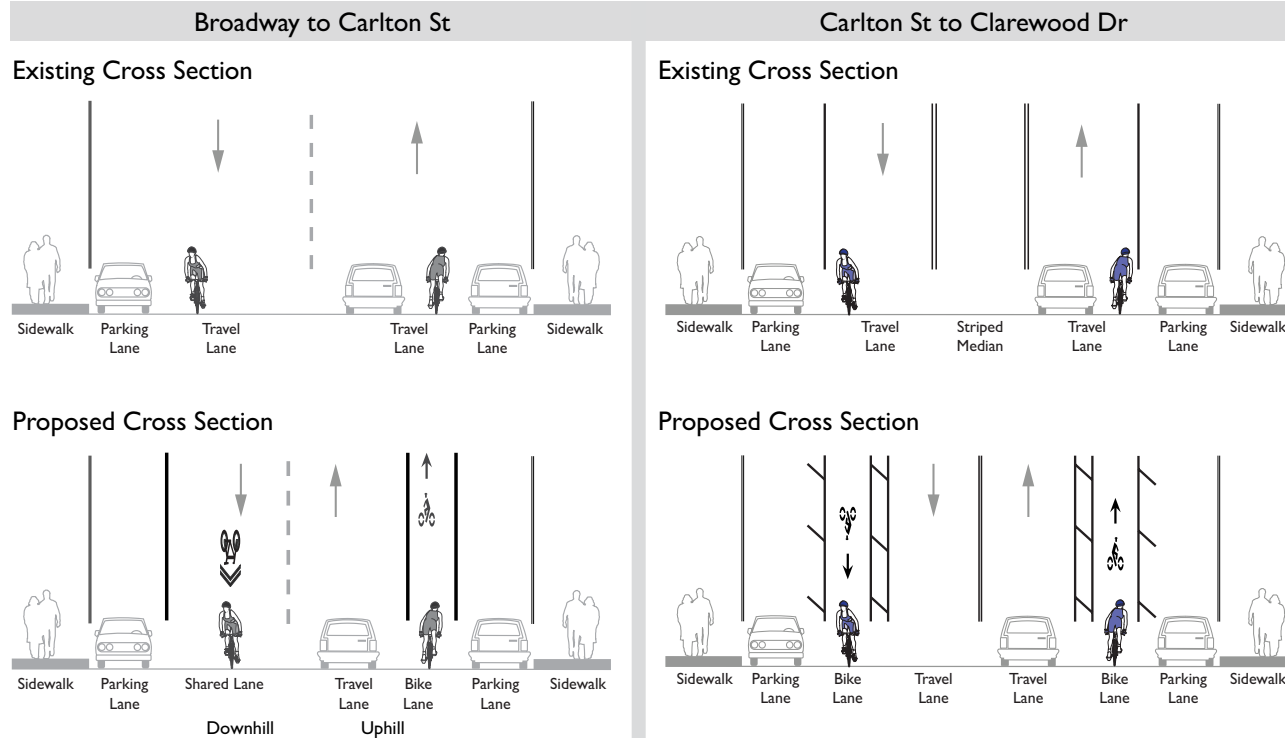
The City of Oakland is proposing to add bike lanes to the existing signage-only bike route on Broadway Ter from Broadway to Clarewood Dr. The bikeway project would be installed in 2017 as part of a scheduled paving project that is funded by Measure BB, the countywide transportation sales tax administered by the Alameda County Transportation Commission.



The bikeway project is recommended in the City's Bicycle Master Plan (BMP). The BMP calls for the installation of bikeways throughout Oakland to encourage bicycling as a healthy, non-polluting and affordable transportation option, helping Oakland achieve City Council-adopted sustainability and livability goals.

DESIGN

The project includes the following designs. From Broadway to Carlton St, the road is not wide enough for bike lanes in both directions. Thus bike lanes will be installed on one side of the street for cyclists traveling slowly in the uphill direction. In the downhill direction, sharrows will be installed in the center of the travel lane. Sharrows encourage bicyclists to ride clear of the "door zone" and advise motorists to expect bicyclists in the travel lane. From Carlton St to Clarewood Dr, buffered bike lanes will be installed by repurposing excess roadway width from the striped median, travel lanes, and shoulders. No parking spaces or left turn pockets will be removed as part of this project. Typical cross sections are shown below.

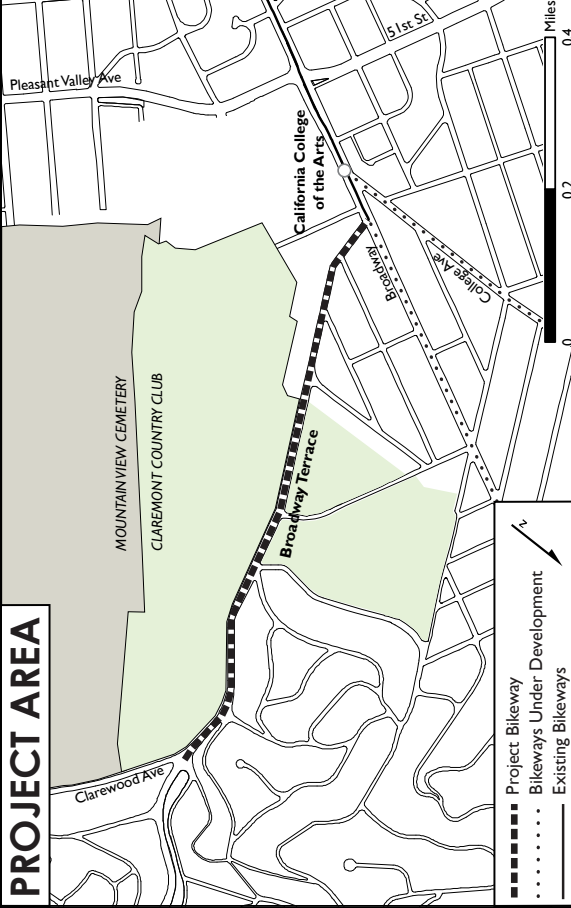

PROJECT AREA



GEOGRAPHIC CONTEXT

The Broadway Terrace Bikeway Project will improve a 0.8-mile section of the City's bikeway network. The new bike lanes will connect to the bike lanes on Broadway from Broadway Ter to 38th St that were installed in 2014. Additional connecting bikeways are under development as part of projects on College Ave and on Broadway between Broadway Ter and Golden Gate Way.
