**Rationale for administrative closure** – The CPRB staff recommends administrative closure of this complaint with a finding of **No Finding** to the allegations as the complainant did not cooperate with the CPRB Investigation.

Complainant alleged that OPD officer threatened him. The complainant also alleged that too many OPD resources were being diverted from West Oakland to cover protests, resulting in calls for service going unanswered in West Oakland.

**Rationale for administrative closure** – It has been determined that the person identified by the complainant as having threatened him is no longer employed by OPD, therefore the CPRB has no jurisdiction to make disciplinary recommendations as to the individual.

The CPRB staff recommends administrative closure of this complaint with a finding of **No Finding** to allegation #2 as there is no MOR violation and it is a service complaint.

The CPRB staff recommends administrative closure of this complaint with a finding of **Unfounded** for allegation #2 as there is no evidence to support that the subject officer planned to kill the complainant.

**Rationale for administrative closure** The CPRB staff recommends administrative closure of this complaint with a finding of **Unfounded** for allegation #1 as there is no evidence to support that the conduct did occur.

The CPRB staff recommends administrative closure of this complaint with a finding of **Unfounded** for allegation #2 as there is no evidence to support that the conduct did occur.

The CPRB staff recommends administrative closure of this complaint with a finding of **No Finding** for allegation #3 as the complainant failed to articulate any specific facts to show which OPD officer may have been involved in the Manual of Rules violation.

The CPRB staff recommends administrative closure of this complaint with a finding of **Exonerated** for allegation #4 as the investigation revealed that the act or acts which provided the basis for the complaint occurred; however, the acts were justified, lawful and proper.
