III. MINUTES

A. October 26, 2017

V. DIRECTOR'S REPORT
(Executive Director Anthony Finnell)

A. Announcements

Director Finnell reported that this past Tuesday night Council did not have comments regarding our request to do our Database and Case Management System. IT and the Vendor have reached an agreement. The Vendor will begin building our Database on November 27 with an expected date of completion to include staff training by the week of February 26, 2018. He reviewed the Statement of Work Order yesterday and made some amendments so they are ready to go.

B. Pending Cases as of November 3, 2017

Director Finnell reported that as of November 9, 2017, there are 48 CPRB cases: 36 are active cases, 9 cases pending closure, 3 tolled cases, and zero cases scheduled for an Evidentiary Hearing. Since the last report was given on October 26, 2017, two new cases were added.

Director Finnell reported that he spoke with the City Administrator yesterday regarding the nine pending cases and she assured him that we will receive her reports by the next Board meeting (December 14).

Commissioner Ball asked Director Finnell to let her know when he receives the reports so that she can review the letters to finalize her documents before the last Board meeting. Director Finnell said he would let her know. She reviewed the update of the nine cases with the dates and the Board met their duty of providing the recommendations to the City Administrator 2-35 days before the 3404 date on all nine cases. She congratulated Board members.

CPRB staff also investigated whether it was proper for OPD officers to pat search complainant's husband and whether the Sergeant properly supervised the officers on the scene.
