## Glass Enclosures

### ***What is the construction?***

Pavilion is designed to be a free-standing transparent glass structure with minimal framing.

### ***How clear is the glass?***

The glass will be largely transparent throughout the structure but may vary due to issues that may arise from safety and constructability.

### ***Will it be perceivable from the lake?***

New Pavilions will be minimally perceivable from the lake during the day.

### ***Will it be attached to the building?***

Per Secretary's standards of historic preservation, all new construction will be fully reversible. Pavilion is designed to be a free-standing structure and will not damage any historic facades.

### ***What are the alternatives to the Pavilions?***

ODI continues to study the design of the pavilions. Current pavilion design incorporates SHPO's comments to pull structure away from front of niche and to provide a second, symmetrical structure on the east portion of the porch.

### ***Distance from Niche?***

Pavilion will be approximately five feet away from niches on the east and the west portions of the facade and will not obstruct artwork within niches.

## Wisteria Detail

### ***Wisteria is very heavy, how will the element be supported?***

Per Secretary's Standards for the Treatment of Historic Properties, all new construction will be fully reversible. Wisteria planters are designed to attach to the least historically significant, south facade in a way that will be non-damaging and fully reversible.
