## Lost Children/Meeting Points

As a precaution, parents and guardians should consider writing their contact information on the forearm of their child. Officers are trained to look on a child's forearm for contact information.

## Tips for Staying Healthy

- Be sure to drink plenty of water (water & beverage stations are noted on the map)
- Be sure to eat
- Use sunscreen and wear a hat to protect yourself from sunburn
- Avoid alcoholic beverages
- Pedestrians watch for cars, trucks and other vehicles
- Know your limits. If you experience dizziness, weakness or nausea at the event, please seek help. You can call 9-1-1 or receive medical assistance at one of the medical tents marked with a giant red balloon around the Rally site. You may also approach any uniformed personnel for assistance.

## Porta-potties

Porta-potties, including ADA units, have been placed on streets parallel to the parade route, usually one block away near major intersections. Porta-potties are also available within the Rally site.

## Transit Information

AC Transit buses will be rerouted around downtown Oakland for most of the day due to street closures. A Temporary Transit Center will operate at Castro Street between 12th and 17th Streets. [www.actransit.org](http://www.actransit.org)
