

**COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PRIORITY CATEGORIES FOR DISTRICTS ONE AND TWO
2017-2019 FUNDING CYCLE
February 24, 2017**

- ◆ Eligible proposals will be considered in the categories of the District-specific services and capital improvements listed below which are described in detail in the attached lists for Districts One and Two.
- ◆ Only proposals addressing the specific priorities below will be accepted and considered for funding.
- ◆ Applicants may request funding to provide the programs/services in both of the two categories below. However programs/services identified in the two categories must not be combined in a single proposal.
- ◆ Applicants requesting funding for more than one priority and/or more than one category must submit a separate proposal for each program/service to be provided in each category.
- ◆ Applicants requesting funding to serve more than one of the two CD Districts (Districts 1-2) must submit a separate complete proposal for each District – identifying the program/service to be provided in that District, the number of clients to be served from that District, the implementation timeframe, and the amount requested from that District allocation.
- ◆ Applicants must cite in each proposal the Priority Code # identified in the respective priority category listing below.

Priority Code #	HOMELESS SERVICES
HS-D1-1	Programs that provide meals, sanitation kits and health related services to homeless individuals and encampments.
HS-D1-2	Programs that provide access to showers and hygiene resources for homeless individuals and encampments, in particular through mobile services.
	HOUSING RELATED SERVICES
HRS-D1-1	Programs that provide fair housing counseling and legal advice to tenants at risk of eviction and predatory rent increases.
	CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS/INFRASTRUCTURE
CI-DI-1	Improvements to enhance street safety, including: sidewalks; crosswalk markings at intersections; additional lighting; designated bicycle lanes; and speed restrictions on truck traffic; with priority for, but not limited to, the Santa Fe Neighborhood and Lowell Street between Stanford Avenue and 53 rd Street.
CI-DI-2	Improvements to heavily trafficked streets to ensure the safety of school students using those avenues of travel, including: school zone crosswalks; restriping to remove center turn lanes; widening of traffic and cycling lanes; traffic circles; and accessible public open space; with priority for, but not limited to, the Longfellow Neighborhood and streets such as West, Market and West MacArthur.

Priority Code #	CRIME AWARENESS AND PREVENTION SERVICES
CAP-D2-1	Programs to reduce crime and increase safety, in particular for seniors, by organizing resident patrols in the Chinatown community.
	HOMELESS SERVICES
HS-D2-1	Programs that provide access, in particular with mobile outreach, for homeless persons to services such as case management, mental and physical health resources, housing referrals, showers and food.
	SENIOR AND DISABLED SERVICES
SDS-D2-1	Programs that provide English as a Second Language (ESL) and other life skills classes for limited-English speaking immigrant seniors.
SDS-D2-2	Provision of subsidized van transportation vouchers for low-income seniors and disabled persons.
	SOCIAL SERVICES
SS-D2-1	Programs that provide services, referrals and support for youth and adult immigrants who speak English as a second language including: ESL classes; vocational training and career counseling; job training and placement; citizenship classes; computer classes; information and referral on housing, health, social and school resources; and life skills workshops.
	YOUTH SERVICES
YS-D2-1	Programs that provide opportunities for summer and year-round internship, apprenticeship and employment as well as career development for youth ages 13 to 19.
YS-D2-2	Programs to inspire and empower youth ages 13 to 19 through outreach and support services, team building, peer connection, development of self-confidence and self-responsibility, and discerning a sense of purpose.
	CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS/INFRASTRUCTURE
CI-D2-1	Creation by nonprofit organizations of one or more community gardens to foster community engagement and education in sustainable gardening practices and edible landscaping skills and provide a source of healthy nutrition for low-income residents in the residential neighborhoods of Lincoln Square Park (261-11 th Street), Chinese Garden Park (7 th and Harrison), Clinton Park (1230-6 th Avenue), San Antonio Park (1701-East 19 th Street), Garfield Park (2260 Foothill Boulevard), Park Boulevard Plaza Park (2100 Park Boulevard), and Madison Square Park (610 Jackson Street).
CI-D2-2	Programs to install, maintain and monitor security cameras at intersections in Chinatown to enhance public safety and reduce crime.
CI-D2-3	Installation of additional street lighting to enhance safety and reduce crime at night in Chinatown.
CI-D2-4	Improvements to the Chinatown Junk Boat Play Structure in the Lincoln Square Playground at 10 th and Alice to install needed equipment and floor surfacing to enhance the safety of and accessibility to the structure.
CI-D2-5	Street improvements to increase traffic safety for students en route to and from Oakland High School, 1023 MacArthur Boulevard.
