Construction Update

Notification of Construction on Hudson Street – Temporary Changes to Casual Carpool, Sidewalks and Parking

June 2010

Dear Community Member:

As part of our system-wide Earthquake Safety Program, strengthening work is in progress on the North Oakland aerial structures, which span from Sycamore Street to the Berkeley Hills Tunnel. Stage one of construction in Hardy Park is nearing completion and will soon be returned to its original condition for public use. Starting in late June, the contractor will place fencing to close a portion of westbound Hudson Street at the corner of Claremont Street and begin to reinforce column foundations.

The following temporary changes will be in effect during this phase of construction (see the diagram on the reverse side of this bulletin):


- **Traffic on westbound Hudson Street will be temporarily shifted to the left.**
- **The casual carpool located on Hudson Street will be temporarily relocated east of the work near Miles Ave.**
- **Some street parking will be temporarily closed on both sides of Hudson Street.**
- **The sidewalk adjacent to the work will be temporarily closed and an ADA accessible walkway will be provided.**

Work hours are 7:00 am – 7:00 pm, Monday through Saturday, with emergency work as necessary. The duration of the work on Hudson Street is approximately three months. Please note that construction traffic will include regular personnel vehicles and occasionally dump trucks, concrete mixers, or other large vehicles. Due to the construction site location, access through residential streets will be necessary. Please watch for signs with notices and safety information.
