#### City of Oakland Advises Downtown Businesses to Delay Start of Work Day Until Further Notice

**Oakland, CA** – As a result of the police enforcement occurring at Frank Ogawa Plaza this morning, the City of Oakland is advising downtown employers to consider having employees delay their arrival downtown this morning until further notice. City employees are also advised to delay their arrival.

The Frank Ogawa Plaza area is contained, but we are in the process of mobilizing the clean-up phase.
