Upcoming Holiday Closure at the City of Oakland *Public Safety Not Affected*

Oakland, CA — The City of Oakland will suspend administrative and other City services for the Veterans' Day holiday on **Monday, November 12**.

While the City's administrative employees are out of the office, if a situation arises that requires more staffing, the City has a plan in place to call in additional resources. **Police, fire and emergency services are not affected during holidays or business closures.**

Specific Service Impacts for Monday, November 12:

Parking Enforcement

- Regular enforcement will occur throughout the City for all parking violations on Monday, November 12.

Public Works

- No street sweeping will occur.
- Serious emergencies – such as sewer overflows, traffic signal outages, objects completely blocking the street to vehicle traffic and major flooding conditions – will be responded to. Please call Public Works Hotline (510) 615-5566 to report issues 24/7, including referring emergency issues.

Oakland Public Library

- All libraries will be closed Monday, November 12.

Office of Parks and Recreation

- Visitors will have access to parks; however gates and restrooms will be closed and staff will not be on site.
- Fee-based programs will continue at participating sites.

Oakland Animal Shelter

- The shelter will have normal business hours of 4 to 7 p.m.

Human Services

Senior Centers

- All senior centers will be closed.

Head Start/Early Head Start Programs

- Head Start and Early Head Start sites will be closed.

Broadway Shuttle

- The shuttle will have a normal operation schedule on Monday, November 12.
