Upcoming Holiday Closure at the City of Oakland
Public Safety Not Affected

Oakland, CA—The City of Oakland administrative offices will be closed on Monday, January 21, in observance of the Martin Luther King, Jr. Day national holiday.

While the City's administrative employees are out of the office, if a situation arises that requires more staffing, the City has a plan in place to call in additional resources. **Police, fire and emergency services are not affected during the holidays or business closures.**

Specific Service Impacts for January 21:

Parking Enforcement

- Monday, January 21, is a parking holiday. Motorists will enjoy free parking at metered spaces throughout Oakland.

Public Works

- No street sweeping will occur.
- Serious emergencies—such as sewer overflows, traffic signal outages, objects completely blocking the street to vehicle traffic and major flooding conditions—will be responded to.

Oakland Public Library

- The Main Library and all branches will be closed on Monday, January 21.
- Branch libraries will be closed Tuesday, January 22, but the Main Library will be open.

Oakland Animal Shelter

- The Animal Shelter will be closed on Monday, January 21.

Oakland Parks and Recreation

- Visitors will have access to parks; however gates and restrooms will be closed and staff will not be on site.
- Fee-based programs will continue at participating sites.

Human Services

Senior Centers

- All Senior Centers will be closed on Monday, January 21.

Head Start/Early Head Start Programs

- All Head Start and Early Head Start program sites will be closed on Monday, January 21.

Broadway Shuttle

- The shuttle will not operate on Monday, January 21.
