Mayor Quan to deliver Oakland State of the City address

What: Oakland Mayor Jean Quan's third annual State of the City address
Where: Council Chambers, City Hall, 1 Frank H. Ogawa Plaza, third floor
When: Thursday, March 6, 2014, 7 p.m.

Please join Mayor Quan for the State of the City Address in Council Chambers at City Hall.

The address will center on Mayor Quan's highest priorities: public safety and economic development. She will take stock of the City's progress in 2013 and set strong goals for the coming year.

While gun violence took a major decline in 2013, the work to make Oakland safer for everyone is far from done. Mayor Quan will **outline specific strategies** for strengthening prevention and law enforcement efforts through increasing resources, following through on strategies that are already proven successful and strengthening relationships between police and the community.

As major development projects, growing local businesses and an expanding economy bring thousands of jobs into Oakland, Mayor Quan will **announce new initiatives** that will work to push those jobs into neighborhoods where unemployment is especially high. This is critical to breaking cycles of generational poverty, which in turn will increase public safety and facilitate swifter, stronger economic development.

Guests and media will be entering from the 14th Street side of the building. A media check-in table will be available on the first floor. Limited media seating and camera space will be available.
