## City of Oakland to Host Second Public Open House on Plan to Run Electric Streetcar or Enhanced Bus System on Broadway

*Oakland, CA* — On Thursday, October 30, the City of Oakland will present analysis and recommendations for how an electric streetcar on tracks or an enhanced bus service might better serve the growing number of downtown workers and visitors, while attracting future private investment along Broadway, downtown Oakland's central spine.

Envisioned as a catalytic project that would strengthen connections between downtown commercial districts, promote economic development and enhance the local transit network, the Broadway Transit Circulator Study is evaluating the feasibility of upgrading and expanding the popular Broadway "B" Shuttle.

Funded by the U.S. Federal Transit Administration through the Caltrans Transportation Planning Grant program, the Study's project area extends from Jack London Square to Kaiser Permanente Hospital, and also includes Brooklyn Basin and the MacArthur and Rockridge BART stations.

The open house will be held on Thursday, October 30, from 6 to 8 p.m., in Hearing Room 3 at Oakland City Hall, 1 Frank H. Ogawa Plaza, which is wheelchair accessible.
