Upcoming Holiday Closures at the City of Oakland *Public Safety Not Affected*

Oakland, CA — The City of Oakland administrative offices will be closed on **Thursday, February 12**, in observance of Lincoln's Birthday and **Monday, February 16**, for the Presidents' Day holiday. City offices will be open during normal business hours on Friday, February 13.

While the City's administrative employees are out of the office, if a situation arises that requires more staffing, the City has a plan in place to call in additional resources. **Police, fire and emergency services are not affected during the holidays or business closures.**

Specific Service Impacts for Thursday, February 12 & Monday, February 16:

Parking Enforcement

- Normal parking enforcement will occur on Thursday, February 12.
- Monday, February 16, is a parking holiday. Motorists will enjoy free parking at metered spaces throughout Oakland.

Public Works

- No street sweeping will occur.
- Serious emergencies—such as sewer overflows, traffic signal outages, objects completely blocking the street to vehicle traffic and major flooding conditions—will be responded to.

Oakland Public Library

- All library locations will be closed Thursday, February 12.
- All locations will be closed on Monday, February 16.
- The Main Library and Brookfield and Eastmont branch libraries will be open on Tuesday, February 17. All other locations will be closed.

Oakland Animal Shelter

- The Animal Shelter will be open on Thursday, February 12.
- The Animal Shelter will be closed on Monday, February 16. People who find stray animals and can not hold them when the shelter is closed, should call (510) 777-3333 between the hours of 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. to be put in touch with a Shelter representative.

Oakland Parks and Recreation

- Visitors will have access to parks; however gates and restrooms will be closed and staff will not be on site.
- Fee-based programs will continue at participating sites.
