Open House Meeting Planned for Interstate 880 29th Avenue Bridge Overcrossing Project

Oakland, Alameda County – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will hold two open house public meetings in March for the 29th Avenue Overcrossing project located in Oakland, Alameda County.

The project will have a closure beginning in April on 29th Avenue between Ford Street and E. 10th Street. This closure will allow crews to demolish the existing 29th Avenue overcrossing and rebuild a new overcrossing in the same location. This closure will continue for approximately 18 months.

Construction Concerns for Residents:

Reconstruction of the new 29th Avenue Overcrossing will result in intermittent night time freeway closures on both Southbound and Northbound Interstate 880, with occasional on-ramp and off-ramp closures. Detours for crossing over Interstate 880 between Oakland and Alameda will be posted to the project website listed below.

California Highway Patrol will be on site during night closures.
