Upcoming Holiday Closure at the City of Oakland *Public Safety Not Affected*

Oakland, CA — The City of Oakland administrative offices will be closed on Monday, May 25, in observance of the Memorial Day holiday.

While the City's administrative employees are out of the office, if a situation arises that requires more staffing, the City has a plan in place to call in additional resources. **Police, fire and emergency services are not affected during the holidays or business closures.**

Specific Service Impacts for Monday, May 25:

Parking Enforcement

- Monday, May 25, is a parking holiday. Motorists will enjoy free parking at metered spaces throughout Oakland.

Public Works

- No street sweeping will occur.
- Serious emergencies—such as sewer overflows, traffic signal outages, objects completely blocking the street to vehicle traffic and major flooding conditions—will be responded to.

Oakland Public Library

- All library locations will be closed on Monday, May 25.
- The Main Library and the Brookfield and Eastmont Branches will be open on Tuesday, May 26. All other branches will be closed.

Oakland Animal Shelter

- The Animal Shelter will be closed on Monday, May 25.
- People who find stray animals and can not hold them when the shelter is closed, should call (510) 777-3333 between the hours of 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. to be put in touch with a Shelter representative.

Oakland Parks and Recreation

- Visitors will have access to parks; however gates and restrooms will be closed and staff will not be on site.
- Fee-based programs will continue at participating sites.

- All Senior Centers will be closed on Monday, May 25.
