Oakland sports its Blue and Gold in honor of Dub Nation's historic run

Oakland, CA — As the Warriors head into Game 6 of the NBA Championship, it's a full-court press to show Oakland's pride in the team's phenomenal performance this season. The championship run, 40 years in the making, has boosted support for the team in a very visible way with blue and yellow lighting displays popping up all over town.

The façade of Oakland's historic City Hall is illuminated nightly with energy-efficient LED lighting and blue and gold lights highlight the cupola.

A "Necklace of Lights" adorns the perimeter of Oakland's crown jewel, Lake Merritt and the nearby Alameda County Courthouse also shines in Warriors colors.

The blue and gold also shines on:

- The Tribune Tower (409 13th St.)
- The KTVU tower (2 Jack London Square)
- The palm trees at Jack London Square (Broadway at Water Street)
- Oracle Arena at night on Game day (7000 Coliseum Way)
