City of Oakland Offices Open on Friday, July 3

Oakland, CA — The City of Oakland administrative offices will be open during normal business hours on Friday, July 3.

However, there are certain City services and sites that will be closed on Saturday, July 4, in observance of the Independence Day holiday. **Police, fire and emergency services are not affected during the holiday closures.**

Specific Service Impacts for Saturday, July 4:

Parking Enforcement

- Saturday, July 4, is a parking holiday. Motorists will enjoy free parking at metered spaces throughout Oakland.

Oakland Public Library

- All library locations will be closed on Saturday, July 4.

Oakland Animal Shelter

- The shelter will be closed on Saturday, July 4.
- People who find stray animals and cannot hold them when the shelter is closed, should call (510) 777-3333 between the hours of 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. to be put in touch with a Shelter representative.

Oakland Parks and Recreation

- Visitors will have access to parks; however gates and restrooms will be closed and staff will not be on site.
- Fee-based programs will continue at participating sites.

Public Works

- No street sweeping will occur.
- Serious emergencies—such as sewer overflows, traffic signal outages, objects completely blocking the street to vehicle traffic and major flooding conditions—will be responded to.
