Upcoming Holiday Closures at the City of Oakland *Public Safety Not Affected*

Oakland, CA — The City of Oakland administrative offices will be closed on Monday, September 7, in observance of the Labor Day holiday and Wednesday, September 9, in observance of California Admission Day holiday.

While the City's administrative employees are out of the office, if a situation arises that requires more staffing, the City has plans in place to call in additional resources. **Police, fire and emergency services are not affected during the holiday closures.**

Specific service impacts for Monday, September 7, and Wednesday, September 9:

Parking Enforcement

- Monday, September 7, is a parking holiday. Motorists will enjoy free parking at metered spaces throughout Oakland.
- Normal parking enforcement will occur on Wednesday, September 9.

Public Works

- No street sweeping will occur on either day.
- Serious emergencies—such as sewer overflows, traffic signal outages, objects completely blocking the street to vehicle traffic and major flooding conditions—will be responded to.

Oakland Public Library

- All library locations will be closed on Monday, September 7, and Wednesday, September 9.
- The Main Library and the Brookfield and Eastmont branches will be open on Tuesday, September 8. All other library locations will be closed that day.

Oakland Animal Shelter

- The Animal Shelter will be closed on Monday, September 7, and Wednesday, September 9.
- People who find stray animals and cannot hold them when the shelter is closed should call (510) 777-3333 between the hours of 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.; a Shelter representative will give instructions on where to deliver the animal.
- Emergency medical calls for injured animals and active bites to humans can be reported through 911.
