Statement about Updating Signs in Oakland Parks

From City of Oakland: Oakland Parks & Recreation and Oakland Public Works

Oakland, CA – Recent media reports and conversations among residents have pointed out that some of the signs in our city parks are outdated. We apologize for any confusion these old signs may have caused. The City is currently in the process of removing and replacing outdated signs throughout our parks. Until all these have been changed, please be assured that the use of musical instruments within our parks is not prohibited. However, a permit is required when a sound amplification system is used. There are also certain restrictions on when city parks are open – typically “dawn to dusk” but from 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. in some places. We will continue to update and replace signage on an ongoing basis to existing park policies are clearly posted and help ensure that everybody can enjoy our parks.
