### Upcoming Holiday Closure at the City of Oakland *Public Safety Not Affected*

#### **Specific Service Impacts for Monday, January 16:**

##### **Parking Enforcement**

- Monday, January 16, is a parking holiday. Motorists will enjoy free parking at metered spaces throughout Oakland.

##### **Public Works**

- No street sweeping will occur.
- Serious Infrastructure Maintenance Issues – emergencies such as sewer overflows, traffic signal outages, a fallen tree and major flooding conditions – should be reported to the Oakland Public Works Call Center at (510) 615-5566, press 0 for an emergency standby crew.

##### **Oakland Public Library**

- All library locations will be closed on Monday, January 16.
- AAMLO will hold its annual MLK Film Festival on Monday, January 16.
- The Main Library and the Brookfield and Eastmont branches will be open on Tuesday, January 17. All other branches will be closed.

##### **Oakland Animal Shelter**

- The Animal Shelter will be closed on Monday, January 16.
- People who find stray animals and cannot hold them when the shelter is closed should call (510) 777-3333; OPD non-emergency dispatch will then contact the Animal Control Officer on call to handle.
- Emergency medical calls for injured animals and active bites to humans can be reported through 911.

##### **Oakland Parks and Recreation**

- Visitors will have access to parks; however gates and restrooms will be closed and staff will not be on site.
- Fee-based programs will continue at participating sites.
