Upcoming Holiday Closures at the City of Oakland *Public Safety Not Affected*

Oakland, CA — The City of Oakland's administrative offices will be closed on **Monday, February 13**, in observance of Lincoln's Birthday and **Monday, February 20**, for the Presidents' Day holiday.

While the City's administrative employees are out of the office, if a situation arises that requires more staffing, the City has a plan in place to call in additional resources. **Police, fire and emergency services are not affected during the holidays or business closures.**

Specific Service Impacts for Monday, February 13 & Monday, February 20:

Parking Enforcement

- Normal parking enforcement will occur on Monday, February 13.
- Monday, February 20, is a parking holiday. Motorists will enjoy free parking at metered spaces throughout Oakland.

Public Works

- No street sweeping will occur.
- Serious emergencies—such as sewer overflows, traffic signal outages, objects completely blocking the street to vehicle traffic and major flooding conditions—will be responded to.

Oakland Public Library

- All library locations will be closed Monday, February 13 and Monday, February 20.
- The Main Library and Brookfield and Eastmont branch libraries will be open on Tuesday, February 14 and Tuesday, February 21. All other locations will be closed on those days.

Oakland Animal Shelter

- The Animal Shelter will be closed on Monday, February 13 and Monday, February 20.
- People who find stray animals and cannot hold them when the shelter is closed should call (510) 777-3333; OPD non-emergency dispatch will then contact the Animal Control Officer on call to handle.
- Emergency medical calls for injured animals and active bites to humans can be reported through 911.

Oakland Parks and Recreation

- Visitors will have access to parks; however gates and restrooms will be closed and staff will not be on site.
- Fee-based programs will continue at participating sites.
