Update on Tragic Death and Injury of Off-duty Oakland Firefighters

Oakland, CA – The San Jose Police Department has arrested Oliver Juinio as a suspect in the shooting death of off-duty Oakland Firefighter Jake P. Walter and the shooting injury of a second off-duty Oakland firefighter, whose name is being withheld out of respect for his privacy. Tipsters may be eligible for a cash reward.


In keeping with his parent's wishes, Firefighter Walter's body will be transported this afternoon in a procession from San Jose to Oakland escorted by the California Highway Patrol, with multiple agencies participating in support of the Oakland Fire Department.

The firefighter who was injured in last night's tragic incident remains in stable condition.
