SUMMARY

Staff requests that the Public Art Advisory Committee (PAAC) review and take action on the preliminary designs by artist Shawn Lovell for the Gardens at Lake Merritt Entry Gates.

BACKGROUND

In May 2010 the PAAC awarded artist Shawn Lovell a commission of \$86,000 for the Measure DD: Gardens at Lake Merritt Entry Gates.

Ms. Lovell, an Oakland-based blacksmith, has developed preliminary designs for two gates, one to be located adjacent to the Garden Center on Bellevue Avenue, the second at the entrance adjacent to the sensory, community and bonsai gardens. Public Art staff convened with the Friends of the Gardens at Lake Merritt, Oakland Parks & Recreation and Public Works Agency representatives to review the designs. Staff now requests preliminary design review by PAAC.

The artist's design intent is to raise awareness and encourage park users to visit the gardens. She will use traditional blacksmithing techniques and materials to forge the gates, which will attach to an existing chain-link fence and will replace the existing standard gates.

Staff recommends that the artist proceed with refining one or more of the designs, based on PAAC design feedback and technical requirements, for presentation to the Friends of the Gardens at Lake Merritt and the Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission for final approval.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

There is no direct financial impact associated with this design review and approval.

REQUEST

Staff requests that the PAAC review and take action on the preliminary designs by artist Shawn Lovell for the Gardens at Lake Merritt Entry Gates.
