



The behavior of a structure is not fully specified by the static forces within it. A structure subject to excitation experiences flutter when positive feedback occurs between the structure's natural mode of vibration and the forces acting on it. Unforeseeable flutter events – sometimes characterized as disorderly outbursts – may undermine the integrity of a structure. Structures are therefore designed to operate within stability boundaries insofar as they can be calculated.



Red Pins - City of Oakland




