## Broadway Transit Circulator Study

The City of Oakland is completing the final stage of the Broadway Transit Circulator Study to evaluate the feasibility of extending the existing Broadway Shuttle route to Kaiser Permanente Hospital and either MacArthur BART or Rockridge BART. The Study, which is funded by the U.S. Federal Transit Administration through the Caltrans Transportation Planning Grant program, is also assessing the potential for either a streetcar (on tracks) or enhanced bus service along Broadway to improve transit efficiency and connectivity, and spur economic development along the corridor. The study area extends from Jack London Square to Kaiser Permanente Hospital, and also includes Brooklyn Basin and the MacArthur & Rockridge BART stations.
