Project Narrative

We are pleased to present the following proposal for the “California Poppies” mural project. This project is in partnership with the families and administration of North Oakland Community Charter School (NOCCS). This mural will be located at 1000 42nd Street and will be installed on the East exterior wall of NOCCS facing Linden Park.

The goal of the design is to integrate the natural beauty of the surrounding community and Linden Park with the facade of NOCCS. It is our hope that the “California Poppies” mural will enhance the experience for all park users, NOCCS students and neighborhood families. The proposed design features the state flower, the California Poppy, over a blue background. We chose the California poppy to show pride in California’s rich Natural heritage. This design is bold, minimal and can be maintained easily. An additional benefit of this project will be a fresh coat of paint, repaired window screens and stucco repair. In addition, parent volunteers who manage the school’s garden program will organize and assist students with the planning of California Poppies in the beds below the mural. This exercise will be incorporated into NOCCS’s existing “Plants and Pollinator” curriculum.

The proposed “California Poppies” mural project will begin on September 15, 2017 and will be completed in approximately two weeks.





## Materials and Methods Descriptions

This project will be completed in two phases, described below:

### Phase 1: Wall prep. and Painting

The screens along the wall will be repaired by being flattened and realigned with the windows. All damaged stucco will be repaired and the wall will then be power-washed.

We plan on applying the background color with an airless paint sprayer for efficiency and best coverage of a large area.

### Phase 2: Mural Installation

A grid system will be used to sketch out the line-work and poppy design. The line-work and poppies will be painted with high quality exterior latex paint and artists grade acrylic paint. This foreground and detailed work will be applied with rollers and brushes.


