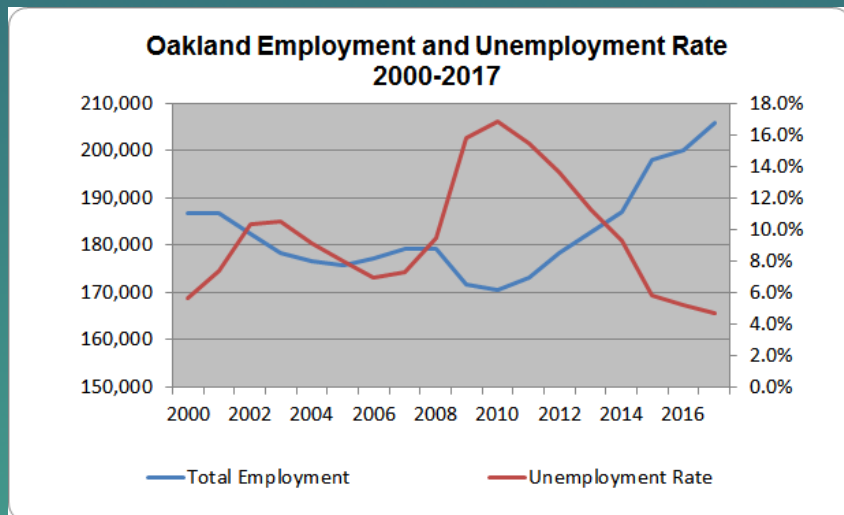

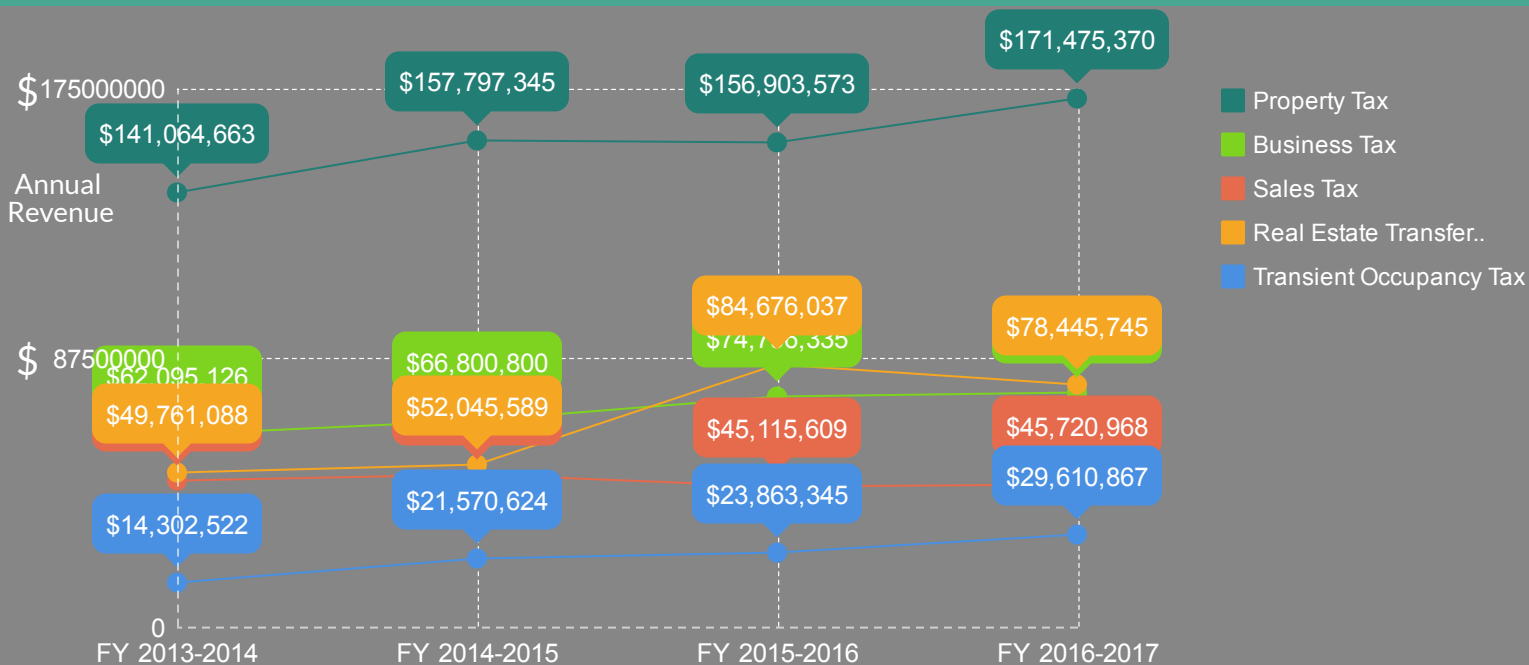

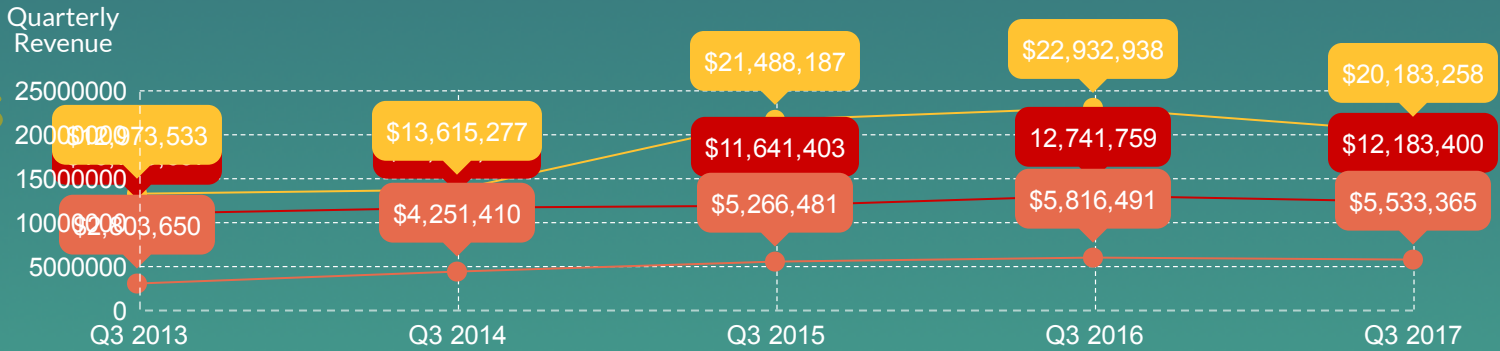

## City Revenue Streams 2014-2017

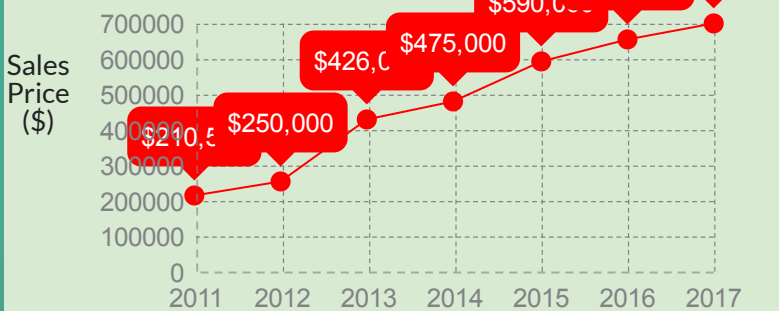
■ Sales Tax ■ Real Estate Transfer Tax ■ Transient Occupancy Tax



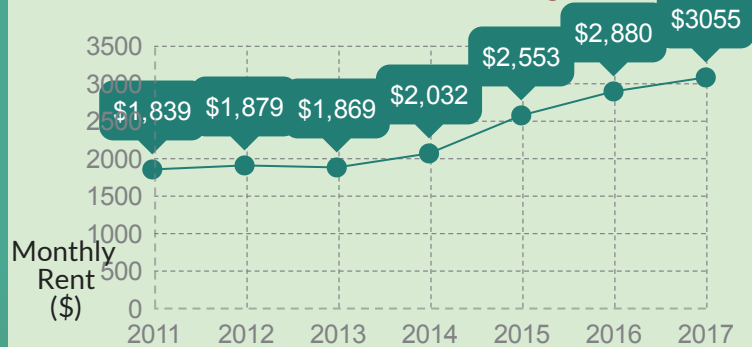

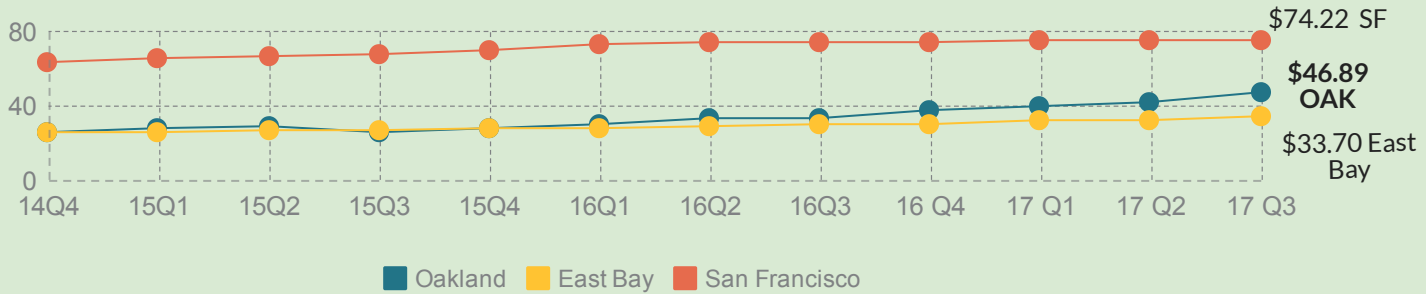

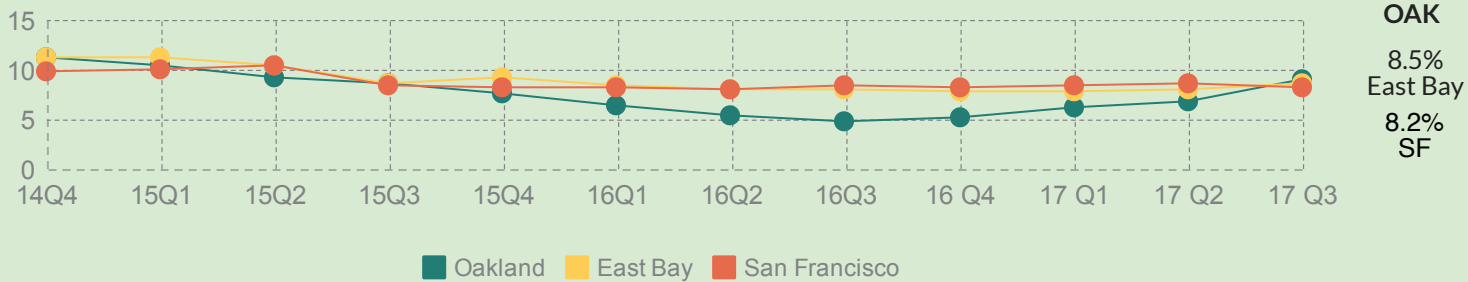

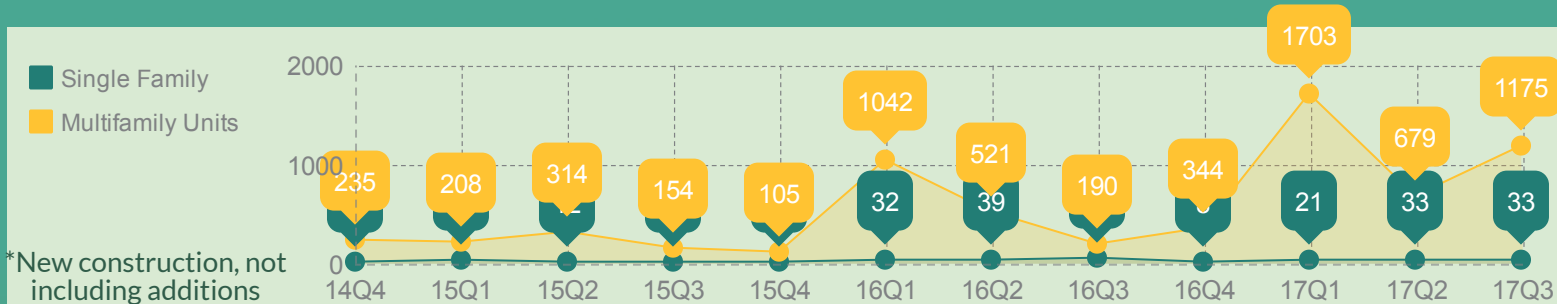
## Office Average Rents/Square Foot
