ST. ANDREW'S PLAZA CLOSING FEBRUARY 2016

The City of Oakland was awarded a State of California Housing Related Parks Grant to renovate St. Andrews Plaza. St. Andrew's Plaza will be closed to public use for the City's planned demolition and re-construction. The City will convene a community planning and design process beginning in February to solicit community input on the re-design and renovation of the Plaza. Given the planning, design and construction schedule anticipated below, the Plaza is expected to re-open Summer 2017.
