The City of Oakland Planning Department invites interested community members to attend a workshop regarding updating the City's zoning regulations for urban agriculture. This process is being initiated because the existing zoning regulations, adopted in 1965, do not adequately address the modern urban agriculture practices that have become popular in Oakland and the nation. The intent of the process is to encourage food production within city limits, clarify standards and review procedures, and ensure responsible and sustainable urban agriculture activities.

This will be the first of two community workshops hosted by the Planning Department before draft zoning regulations are presented to the Planning Commission and the City Council. The workshop will focus on reviewing the background of urban agriculture in Oakland and identifying issues that the City should consider in formulating urban agricultural policy.
