INFORMATION

It is with great pleasure that I announce the appointment of Anthony Toribio as Acting Deputy Chief of Police, in charge of the Bureau of Risk Management and Sean Whent to Acting Captain of Police, to serve as the Commander of the Office of the Inspector General.

Acting Deputy Chief Captain Toribio is a 22 year veteran with the Oakland Police Department, who embodies the qualities needed to effectively carryout the duties of Deputy Chief of Police. Acting Deputy Chief Toribio has a range of experience and knowledge within the agency. As the Commander of the Office of Inspector General, Acting Deputy Chief Toribio was responsible for providing the Chief of Police regular briefings and analysis associated with the Negotiated Settlement Agreement (NSA), developing and revising Department policies and procedures, and conducting audits and reviews to ensure compliance with the Negotiated Settlement Agreement. As the Commander for Area One (West and North Oakland, including Downtown), he was responsible for all patrol operations in his area, including crime reduction and problem solving efforts, emergency/response to calls for service, and managing Problem Solving Officers and community policing efforts. As an Internal Affairs Commander, Acting Deputy Chief Toribio was responsible for overseeing all internal affairs investigations related to allegations of police misconduct.

Acting Police Captain Whent joined the Department in 1996 and worked in the Patrol Division in all areas of the City. He has worked as a field training officer, a member of the Police and Corrections Team, and in the Criminal Investigations Division. As a Sergeant, he worked as a patrol supervisor and as an investigator in Internal Affairs. As a Lieutenant, he worked as a Patrol watch commander, in the Internal Affairs Division, and the Office of Inspector General. He also served as the Acting Captain in the Internal Affairs Division for nearly two years.


