INFORMATION

This memo provides an update on the Zero Waste Services Request For Proposals (RFP) process:

- Two proposals have been received for waste collection services; two for recycling collection services; and one for landfill disposal.
- The proposals have been reviewed as required by the Council approved Zero Waste Process. The review panel recommended simultaneous negotiation with both proposers, Waste Management of Alameda County, Inc. and California Waste Solutions
- The protest period opened on May 16 for a five day period, closing on May 22. The City received two protests which are being reviewed.
- Once the review is complete (estimated to be within 10 days) another Information Memo will be issued advising the City Council of the outcome.
- Effective today the limited communication period know as the “Cone of Silence” under the Protocol for Process Integrity has ended. All parties are now free to communicate with each other.
- The Agenda Report requesting permission to negotiate with both proposers will be heard by the Public Works Committee on Tuesday, May 28.
