Specific Service Impacts for November 11:

Parking Enforcement

- Normal parking enforcement throughout the City for all violations will occur on Tuesday, November 11.

Public Works

- No street sweeping will occur.
- Serious emergencies—such as sewer overflows, traffic signal outages, objects completely blocking the street to vehicle traffic and major flooding conditions—will be responded to.

Oakland Public Library

- The Main Library and all branches will be closed on Tuesday, November 11.

Oakland Animal Shelter

- The Animal Shelter will be closed on Tuesday, November 11.
- People who find stray animals and can not hold them when the shelter is closed, should call (510) 777-3333 between the hours of 7am to 3:30pm to be put in touch with a Shelter representative.

Oakland Parks and Recreation

- Visitors will have access to parks; however gates and restrooms will be closed and staff will not be on site.
- Fee-based programs will continue at participating sites.
