**RESOLUTION NO. 18-01**  
**[Approved 2-5-18]**

**By action of the Oakland Public Ethics Commission:**

**WHEREAS**, Oakland City Charter Section 202 requires the Public Ethics Commission (Commission) to bi-annually adjust City Councilmember salaries by the increase in the Consumer Price Index over the preceding two years and to optionally adjust salaries beyond the increase in the Consumer Price Index up to a total of five percent per year; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commission-authorized annual salary for Oakland City Councilmembers is \$85,382.97, effective July 2016; and

**WHEREAS**, some Oakland City Councilmembers have declined salary increases in past years and are currently taking a salary of \$79,677 or more; and

**WHEREAS**, the consumer price index for the San Francisco Bay Area increased by a total of 6.6 percent between January 2016 and December 2017; and

**Now, therefore be it:**

**RESOLVED**, that the Commission does hereby authorize a salary increase of 6.6 percent for the office of City Councilmember as mandated by City Charter Section 202, for a total annual salary of up to \$91,018.25, effective as of the first payroll period of Fiscal Year 2018-19; and


**RESOLVED**, that the Commission does not authorize any additional increase beyond that required by the Oakland City Charter.
