FACT SHEET

The cities of Alameda, Oakland and San Leandro are joining together to launch the **Corridor of Safety**, a partnership that will cover more than 83 square miles and protect more than 555,000 residents in the event of a disaster. The cities are developing new Alerting & Warning Siren Systems to alert and inform the public and to train them to follow three simple steps when sirens sound: Shelter, Shut and Listen. Activation and testing of these prototype siren systems begin Wednesday February 5th 2003 at 12 noon. Following this kickoff the sirens will continue to be tested the first Wednesday of each month.
