Shelter Fundamentals Class

This is a basic level course that introduces the guidelines and procedures for setting up, running, and closing a shelter during a disaster. Referencing supplied shelter checklists, participants will work on a case study that takes them through four of the six phases of the sheltering process: Resourcing, Opening, Operating and Closing the shelter.

Prerequisite: None

Shelter Management Class:

This is a basic level class that introduces the roles, responsibilities and tasks of the shelter manager. This class will prepare participants to successfully act as a shelter manager during a disaster.
