


CORE Citywide Emergency Response Functional Exercise

Our goal is to practice **neighborhood evacuation** and **demonstrate effective communication** on 4 levels:

- individual
- within the neighborhood
- to another neighborhood
- to the City's Emergency Operations Center.

Everyone can participate—and it's completely free!

The Exercise's principal players are Oakland neighborhood groups led by CORE-trained volunteers. Other organized groups such as Neighborhood Watch are encouraged to participate as well.

Individuals with no prior experience or training are welcome to take part as Spontaneous Volunteers or Volunteer Victims.

CORE-trained volunteers who are not in an organized neighborhood are needed as Exercise Coaches to assist new / inexperienced groups, or as Embedded Team Members to participate in another neighborhood.
