Things that you can do to become prepared:

1. Join local community efforts to organize communication base (phone tree) in order to become informed about the disaster.. To help yourself, to help others.
Always follow instructions of law enforcement.
2. Become informed: What should you do in the event of a disaster or emergency? Find out before disaster strikes by ordering Emergency/Disaster Preparedness Supplies from FEMA.GOV
