Mayor Dellums to Join Vice Mayor Reid at Community Town Hall Meeting

Oakland, CA – Mayor Ron Dellums will join Vice Mayor, Councilmember Dist. 7, Larry Reid on Wednesday, October 22 to convene a Neighbor to Neighbor Town Hall Meeting at Castlemont Community of Small Schools. The purpose of the event is to encourage an informative and insightful exchange of ideas on issues that impact all Oaklanders - particularly for residents in District 7, during this town hall.
