Three suspects captured after home break-in

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE - Oakland Arrests Suspect in Double Homicide; DA Charges #OaklandPolice

Oakland, CA – The Oakland Police Department has arrested Francisco Jesus Hernandez, 37, of Oakland, in connection with a double homicide and an attempted homicide which occurred on August 8, 2016 at 1:46 AM, in the 9900 block of Empire Road. Two male victims suffered fatal gunshot wounds and the third male victim was critically wounded. Hernandez was arrested on Monday, August 8, 2016.

The Alameda County District Attorney's Office charged Hernandez on August 10, 2016. At this time, Oakland police are awaiting the Alameda County Coroner's Office to positively identify the two homicide victims.

BACKGROUND: On August 8, 2016, at 1:46 AM, Oakland police officers responded to a reporting of a shooting in the 9900 block of Empire Road.

When officers arrived at the scene, they located three victims suffering from multiple gunshot wounds. Emergency medical personnel responded to the scene to provide aid to the victims. The third victim was hospitalized and is expected to recover from his injuries.

Homicides solved

Arrests made in recent cases, DA charges

The Oakland Police Department has arrested an 18-year-old Oakland man for the homicide of Oakland resident Arturo Hector Barrera Rodriquez, 43. The Alameda County District Attorney's Office has charged Danny Sakeem Hogg of Oakland with the murder of Rodriquez which occurred on the evening of June 9, 2016.

BACKGROUND: On June 9, 2016, at approximately 10:10 p.m., Oakland police officers responded to a shooting in the 2800 block of 38th Avenue. Emergency personnel arrived on scene, provided first aid, but he was pronounced deceased.

The Oakland Police Department has arrested a 24-year-old Hayward man for the homicide of Oakland resident Marcus West, Jr., 22. The Alameda County District Attorney's Office has charged DeShawn Christy with the murder of West which occurred on the morning of March 3, 2015.

BACKGROUND: On March 3, 2015, at approximately 7:03 a.m., Oakland police officers responded to a shooting in the 4700 block of Scotia Avenue. When officers arrived on scene, they located the victim suffering from multiple gunshot wounds. Emergency personnel provided first aid, but he was pronounced deceased at the scene.

The Oakland Police Department has arrested an 18-year-old Oakland man for the homicide of 20-year-old Javiya Evans of Oakland. The Alameda County District Attorney's Office has charged Shermon Freemon with the murder of Evans which occurred on the morning of June 23, 2016.

BACKGROUND: On June 23, 2016, at approximately 8:14 a.m., Oakland police officers responded to a shooting in the 6300 block of Baker Street. Officers located the victim suffering from multiple gunshot wounds. The victim was transported to a local hospital where he succumbed to his injuries.




Karl Joseph, the 14th pick overall in the 2016 National Football League draft, played safety at West Virginia.
