**Homicide**

*The Oakland Police Department Requests the Public's Help*

**Oakland (CA)** – On July 18, 2010 at 11:32 PM Oakland Police Department Patrol Division Officers responded to the 1900 Webster on the report of the sound of gunshots and people running down Webster towards 20<sup>th</sup> St. Upon arrival officers found Jinghong Kang, 45-year-old, Male, Fairfax, Virginia resident suffering from an apparent gunshot wound(s).

Emergency medical personnel responded and pronounced Kang dead.

Oakland Homicide Investigators responded to the scene and began the follow-up investigation into the circumstances regarding the shooting. During the investigation, the following suspect information was determined:

- 1) Male, black, 18-25-years-old, 5'-8" to 5'-10", 160-170 lbs, wearing a black hooded sweat shirt and blue jeans
- 2) Female, black, 18-25-years-old, 5'-3" to 5'-6", 140-150 lbs, wearing a multi-colored jacket and gray pants
