OAKLAND POLICE ARREST SUSPECTED SHOOTER

On December 11, 2010, at approximately 11:00 P.M, Oakland Police Officers were dispatched to 420 14th St on reports of a large crowd gathering outside of a party. Officers arrived on scene and found a crowd of 100 people gathered on the sidewalk and in the street. At 11:15 P.M. officers heard rapid gun fire coming from the area of 12th and Broadway. Patrol Officers then observed a male armed with a gun running South on Broadway and then East on 11th St. They were able to take him into custody and recover the firearm in the 400 block of 11th St. Officers located two victims suffering from gun shot wounds in the area, a 19 year old man from Richmond and a 14 year old girl from Oakland, both with non-life threatening wounds. A Criminal Investigation Division call out was initiated and the suspect was transported to the Criminal Investigation Division.

Upon questioning the suspect stated that he intentionally shot the male victim with the intention of killing him. The suspect is an Oakland Resident. This shooting appears to stem from an altercation between rival gangs.
