## Oakland Police Disrupt Major Drug Trafficking Operation

On February 12th, the Oakland Police Department served a search warrant at the residence at 1292 61<sup>st</sup> Ave. The warrant was the result of a proactive investigation headed by patrol officer Eric Karsseboom. Inside the residence, officers located approximately 200 ounces of heroin, 2 ounces of crystal methamphetamine, 1 ounce of cocaine, a firearm, and \$8,800 in U.S. Currency. The seizure is the largest recovery of narcotics in the City of Oakland in recent years, and represents a significant disruption in a major narcotics operation. The resident and suspect believed to be the head of the distribution operation was arrested and has been identified as 35-year-old Oakland resident Isaac Perez.
