Multiple Shooting at 32nd Street

Oakland, CA – On June 20, 2011, at approximately 8:27 P.M., Oakland Police Officer's were dispatched to 32nd St and Market St. to investigate a report of a shooting. Upon arrival, Officers discovered that the crime scene was actually in the 800 block of 32nd Street. They responded there and learned that three male adults and one female adult had been shot. The victims were self transported to local hospitals for treatment. One of the male adult victim's was subsequently pronounced deceased at 9:12 P.M. at a local hospital. The male adult victim was identified as 18 year old Dionte Freeman, an Oakland resident.

Homicide investigators were called out to begin the follow up investigation into the circumstances regarding the shooting. There are no arrests at this time and the motive is unknown at this time. Anyone with information is asked to contact the Homicide Section at (510) 238-3821.
