Teens Charged With Murder in the Death of Concord Man

Oakland, CA — Today Andrew Lucero, 19, Jason Hunter, 19, and Samuel Garcia, 16, were charged by the Alameda County District Attorney's Office with murder in the shooting death of 25-year-old Pretis Golson-Jackson.

On July 15th, 2011, Golson- Jackson and the three suspects were in an apartment in the 2400 block of 106th Ave. when they got into an argument. Golson-Jackson was shot, and died at a local hospital the next morning.

Homicide investigators Sgt. R. Van Sloten and Sgt. J. Rullamas conducted a thorough investigation and developed information that led to the identification and arrests of Garcia, a juvenile being charged as an adult, and Lucero on the 16th of July. Hunter was arrested on the 17th of July, and in addition to the murder charge was charged with being a felon in possession of a firearm.
