### **The Oakland Police Department, US Marshals and other law enforcement agencies partnered to conduct a city wide operation.**

**Oakland, CA** –On November 10, 2011, Oakland Police Chief Howard Jordan was accompanied by US Marshal Donald O’Keefe, US Attorney Melina Haag, Mayor Jean Quan, Alameda County District Attorney Nancy O’Malley, City Administrator Deanna Santana and Director Ron Brooks of the Northern California HIDTA task force in a joint press conference to announce the successful completion of a joint operation. Oakland police have partnered with the US Marshals Service Pacific Southwest Regional Fugitive Task Force, California Department of Corrections, California Highway Patrol and other Federal, State, County and City law enforcement agencies to conduct a multi stage warrant sweep and “hot spot” saturation operation.

In the last week, several multi agency teams of law enforcement officers have safely located and arrested subjects for which state arrest warrants have been issued. Teams have also conducted saturation patrols in identified violent crime “hot spots” in an effort to prevent acts of violent crimes as well as apprehending warrant suspects. Teams conducted probation, parole and sex offender compliance checks, as well as executing searches at residences associated with known criminal activity and or acts of violence. In addition, the Oakland Police Department’s Major Crimes Unit gathered intelligence information related to violent crime.
