Oakland Police Need Your Help

In Bank Robbery Case

Oakland, CA - On December 16, 2011 at approximately 4:53 pm a bank robbery occurred at the Wells Fargo located at 2220 Mountain Boulevard. Investigators have reason to believe the same individual is responsible for committing another recent bank robbery on December 13, 2011, at the Chase Bank located at 3310 International Boulevard. In both incidents the suspect approached the teller and demanded money. The suspect is described as an African-American male with a dark complexion in his late 20's to 40's, approximately 5'5" to 5'6" tall, 160-170 pounds, with black hair, brown eyes, and a beard. He was wearing glasses possibly with a dark frame and a purple tinted lenses, black hat, black hooded coat. After committing the robbery, the suspect fled on foot. The attached photo shows the suspect at the Wells Fargo Bank teller window.

Back Ground: On December 13, 2011 at approximately 5:40 pm, it is believed the suspect described above committed a bank robbery at the Chase Bank located at 3310 International Boulevard. The suspect approached the teller and demanded money, as in the robbery described above. The suspect in this case is described as an African-American male with a dark complexion in his 30's, approximately 5'5" to 5'6" tall, 160-170 pounds, with black hair, brown eyes, and appeared unshaven. He was wearing glasses possibly with a dark frame, black hat, black sweater, and a black puffy coat. After committing the robbery, the suspect fled on foot. The attached photo shows the suspect at the Chase Bank teller window
