On February 4, 2012, at 7:30 p.m. a crowd of approximately 50 persons peacefully assembled at Frank H. Ogawa Plaza. By 8:54 p.m, Oakland Police facilitated a circuitous march of approximately 100 through the downtown streets of Oakland between the hours of 8:54 p.m. and 11:00p.m.

Although social media sites had indicated that individuals or groups planned a, “militant, radical march” and asked peaceful bystanders to not interfere with criminal tactics, the march this evening overall was peaceful.

The Oakland Police Department reported that there were no reports of violence, arson, vandalism, or injury to protesters or police and no arrests were made.

The only incident reported early in the evening, was approximately ten protesters wearing masks at Frank Ogawa Plaza, threw several large bottles of suspected urine at the media.
