On February 20, 2012, at 11:43 p.m., a uniformed Oakland Police Officer attempted to conduct a traffic enforcement stop in 2000 block of 62<sup>nd</sup> avenue on a vehicle associated to a robbery, which had just occurred in the area. The vehicle had at least two occupants. One of the passengers ran from the vehicle. The officer ran after the passenger, and discovered the passenger was in possession of a firearm. The officer discharged his firearm, which struck the passenger. Medical attention was provided at the scene to the passenger who was then medically transported to a local hospital where he is listed in stable condition. Officers recovered a firearm from the scene. Police are looking for the driver who fled the scene and the vehicle.

The Oakland Police Department's Major Crimes Unit and Internal Affairs Division responded to the scene and have begun an independent investigation into this case.
