**Oakland Police Make Arrests and Recover Assault Weapons and Narcotics**

*Oakland, CA* —This past weekend, Oakland police officers and Crime Reduction Team officers made two notable arrests, recovering illegally possessed firearms and narcotics in both instances.

On March 24, 2012, at 2:01 p.m., Oakland patrol officers responded to the 10200 block of Longfellow Avenue, to investigate a report of domestic violence involving a firearm. Officers arrested one male adult and recovered two guns - an assault rifle and one handgun - along with several illegal high capacity magazines and ammunition. Officers additionally recovered large quantities of marijuana and various amounts of ecstasy pills.

On March 23, 2012, at 6:13 p.m., Crime Reduction officers were proactively patrolling the 5700 block of Elizabeth Street., when they observed a suspicious vehicle containing one male adult occupant. The investigation led officers to the 3400 block of 64<sup>th</sup> Avenue Place where officers recovered illegal firearms and large amounts of Marijuana. Officers recovered one assault rifle, one handgun and illegal high capacity magazines. A total of three male adults were arrested.

These arrests and recoveries are representative of the Department's latest progress in addressing violent crime.
